THE PROJECT

OUR GANG FOR LIFE? PROJECT WAS DESIGNED TO EDUCATE CHILDREN THROUGH INTERACTIVE WORKSHOPS ON ALL THE DANGERS THAT ARE ASSOCIATED WITH BEING RECRUITED OR EXPLOITED BY CRIMINAL GANGS, AND TO PROVIDE PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES IN THE FORM OF BOXING CIRCUIT CLASSES THAT HELP TO PROMOTE GOOD PHYSICAL AND MENTAL WELLBEING.

WE DELIVERED THESE SESSIONS MAINLY IN PRU'S (PUPIL REFERRAL UNITS) AND PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN GREATER MANCHESTER, WHERE MOST OF OUR TARGET BENEFICIARIES ATTEND FOR THEIR EDUCATION.

THE NEED FOR OUR PROJECT IN THESE LOCATIONS HAS FAR EXCEEDED OUR EXPECTATIONS. SINCE OUR PROJECT BEGAN, WE HAVE BEEN APPROACHED BY MORE PRU'S IN GREATER MANCHESTER ASKING OUR CHARITY TO WORK WITH THEIR MOST "HARD TO REACH COHORTS OF STUDENTS" WITH THIS PROJECT. OUTCOMES

98% OF ALL BENEFICIARIES AGED 12 AND ABOVE KNEW HOW TO SAY “NO” IF ASKED TO JOIN A GANG, AND WHERE TO GET HELP IF ALREADY INVOLVED IN GANG LIFE.

100% OF ALL BENEFICIARIES AGED 11 AND UNDER KNEW HOW TO SAY NO IF ASKED TO JOIN A GANG, AND WHERE TO GET HELP IF ALREADY INVOLVED IN GANG LIFE. 4% IN THIS AGE GROUP ADMITTED THAT THEY MAY BE TOO FEARFUL TO REPORT IF ASKED TO JOIN A GANG.

100% OF ALL BENEFICIARIES SAID THEY WERE NOW AWARE OF ALL THE DANGERS ASSOCIATED WITH GANG LIFE.

PRIOR TO THE PROJECT ONLY 10% OF BENEFICIARIES HAD SOME PRIOR KNOWLEDGE OF WHAT COUNTY LINES/GOINGCOUNTRY IS. AFTER THE PROJECT 100% HAD KNOWLEDGE ON THIS SUBJECT.

99% OF ALL BENEFICIARIES ENJOYED THE SPORTS SESSIONS AND THAT THEY NOW HAD A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF HOW SPORTS CAN IMPROVE BOTH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH.

AT THE BEGINNING OF FUNDRAISING FOR THIS PROJECT, 6 SAFETY BOXES WERE DONATED AND HAVE BEEN USED AS AMNESTY BINS IN THE LOCATIONS WE HAVE WORKED. 95% OF ALL BENEFICIARIES WERE NOT AWARE OF AMNESTY BINS OR THEIR USE. WE HAVE ALREADY HAD KNIVES AND DRUG PARAPHINALIA “DROPPED” INTO THE BINS, WHICH HAVE SAFELY REMOVED FROM THE BINS AND “DROPPED” INTO AMNESTY BINS AT GMP LOCATIONS.

THE “REAL LIFE STORY” FROM EX GANG MEMBER JASON HAD A HUGE IMPACT ON ALL OUR BENEFICIARIES AND REALLY ENCOURAGED THEM TO SHARE THEIR OWN LIVED EXPERIENCES. THIS HAS BEEN A GREAT BENEFIT TO PREVENT 2 PROTECT AND HAS ENABLED US TO GET A REAL TAKE ON WHAT OUR BENEFICIARIES FACE IN TODAYS SOCIETY.

2 OF THE LOCATIONS WE VISITED HAVE ASKED US IF WE CAN PROVIDE 1-2-1 MENTORING TO THEIR STUDENTS THAT ARE HAVING ISSUES WITH GANGS AND/OR CRIME.

100% OF THE LOCATIONS WE HAVE PROVIDED OUR PROJECT TO WOULD LIKE FOR US TO RETURN AND WORK WITH THEIR STUDENTS AGAIN, SOME WANT THE SPORTS ON A WEEKLY BASIS IF POSSIBLE.

WHAT DID THE CHARITY LEARN FROM THIS PROJECT?

WE HAVE LEARNED THAT THERE IS A HUGE NEED FOR THIS PROJECT WITHIN PRU'S THAT WE INITIALLY ANTICIPATED. (A LIST HAS BEEN PROVIDED AT THE END OF THIS REPORT).

DURING THE PROJECT, JASON SHARED HIS OWN LIFE STORY WITH THE BENEFICIARIES AS PART OF THE EDUCATION SESSIONS. WE LEARNED THAT WE NEEDED TO MAKE HIS STORY MORE "HARD HITTING" WITH BENEFICIARIES AGED 14 AND ABOVE. WE ASKED JASON IF HE WAS HAPPY TO SHARE MORE STORIES FROM HIS TIME IN PRISON AND THE THINGS HE SAW. THIS HAS MADE A HUGE IMPACT ON BENEFICIARIES OF THAT AGE GROUP.

WE FOUND THAT MANY BENEFICIARIES WE SPOKE WITH ON THIS PROJECT THAT HAD A CAREER PLAN WANTED TO JOIN THE ARMED FORCES. PREVENT 2 PROTECT CONTACTED THE LOCAL ARMY RESERVE AND ASKED IF THEY WOULD BE HAPPY TO ASSIST US WITH THE DELIVERY OF THIS PROJECT AND TO OFFER CAREERS ADVICE TO THOSE INTERESTED. THE ARMY ARE LOOKING TO JOIN THIS PROJECT ONCE ALL COVID RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN LIFTED, TO HELP WITH DELIVERY OF OUR SPORTS SESSIONS INCLUDING THE USE OF SOME OF THEIR EQUIPMENT AND USE OF THEIR LOCATIONS. THEY ARE VERY HAPPY TO OFFER CAREERS ADVICE WHERE NEEDED.

FEEDBACK FROM STAFF AT PRU'S AND SCHOOLS

"THE PREVENT 2 PROTECT TEAM CAME INTO BROADWALK TO RUN A WORKSHOP ABOUT GANGS AND CRIME. DID THE MESSAGE ABOUT THE PROMOTION OF HEALTH AND WELLBEING COME ACROSS? YES, THE MESSAGE ABOUT THIS CAME ACROSS STRONGLY FOR BOTH STAFF AND STUDENTS. THIS WAS A UNANIMOUS VIEW (BOTH STAFF AND STUDENTS)

DO YOU HAVE ANY SUGGESTIONS OF HOW TO IMPROVE THE SESSION? NO

DO YOU HAVE ANY FEEDBACK FOR OUR TEAM? STAFF WERE IMPRESSED AT THE SPEED AT WHICH THE WORKERS WERE ABLE TO ENGAGE OUR STUDENTS. WORKERS WERE RESPECTFUL OF PERSONAL SPACE AND INTERACTED AND INVOLVED PRU STAFF. THE TEAM WORKED VERY WELL WITH SOME OF THE MOST-HARD TO REACH STUDENTS IN THE AUTHORITY. THEY QUICKLY BUILT RELATIONSHIPS THAT HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO BE BUILT UPON MOVING FORWARDS IF IT IS AN OPTION TO HAVE P2P BACK IN SCHOOL.

IN A SHORT PARAGRAPH PLEASE CAN YOU SUMMARISE YOUR THOUGHTS ON THE GANG FOR LIFE? SESSIONS

THE SESSIONS HAVE BEEN BENEFICIAL IN PROVIDING OUR STUDENTS WITH A SAFE AND INFORMATIVE SPACE TO LEARN ABOUT WELLBEING AND THE CHOICES THEY MAKE. THIS WILL HOPEFULLY INFORM HOW THEIR LIVES MAY TURN OUT IN THE FUTURES. WORKERS WERE OPEN AND HONEST ABOUT THEIR LIVED EXPERIENCES WHICH ALLOWED SOME OF OUR STUDENTS A WINDOW INTO THE POSSIBLE CHOICES AND RAMIFICATIONS OF THESE CHOICES. THE OVERALL OPINION FROM SCHOOL STAFF OBSERVED THAT THE STUDENTS ENGAGED WELL BECAUSE THEY DIDNT FEEL JUDGED AND THE SAFETY OF THIS ATMOSPHERE ALLOWED THEM TO JOIN IN KNOWING IT WAS OK JUST TO "HAVE A GO" AT

THE DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES ON OFFER. THE WORK FITS NICELY INTO THE PSE CURRICULUM THAT STUDENTS ARE CURRENTLY STUDYING AROUND EMOTIONAL WELL BEING, DRUG EDUCATION AND RELATIONSHIPS. FROM A SCHOOL PERSPECTIVE IT IS ALWAYS A PRIVILEGE TO WORK WITH ORGANISATIONS WHO COMPLETELY UNDERSTAND THE NEEDS OF OUR STUDENTS. IT IS CLEAR THAT P2P HAVE THE SYNERGY THAT IS NECESSARY TO IGNITE TO MINDS OF OUR HARD-TO-REACH COHORT OF STUDENTS. WE WOULD REALLY APPRECIATE MORE SESSIONS IF THAT COULD BE MADE POSSIBLE. WHAT THE LOCAL MEDIA SAYS ABOUT OUR PROJECT

WE WERE APPROACHED BY CIARAN BALL A REPORTER FOR THE ONLINE PAPER SALFORD NOW. HE HEARD ABOUT OUR PROJECT IN SALFORD AND WROTE AN ARTICLE ABOUT OUR WORK.

“A SALFORD CHARITY IS HELPING SCHOOL STUDENTS ACROSS GREATER MANCHESTER TO PUT AN END TO GANG VIOLENCE AROUND THE REGION. THE CHARITY ‘PREVENT 2 PROTECT’ ARE PROVIDING SCHOOLS KNIFE AMNESTY BOXES IN ITS CURRENT PROJECT ‘GANGS FOR LIFE?’. THEIR AIM IS TO USE WORKSHOPS WITHIN SCHOOL CLASSES TO EDUCATE CHILDREN ON TOPICS SUCH AS SALFORD KNIFE CRIME, GANG VIOLENCE, DOMESTIC ABUSE, FORCED MARRIAGE AND MANY MORE SITUATIONS. THE PROJECT IS HOPING TO PREVENT THEM FROM BEING INFLUENCED BY GANGS AND THE FEELING OF CONFIDENCE WITH USING A KNIFE IN AN EVERYDAY OCCURRENCE. ‘PREVENT 2 PROTECT’ IS ALSO OFFERING YOUNG CHILDREN THE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN NEW SKILLS, SUCH AS COOKING AND FITNESS CLASSES TO KEEP THE SPIRITS HIGH. DANIELLA NUTTALL FROM ‘PREVENT 2 PROTECT’ SAID: “SCHOOLS IN GREATER MANCHESTER AND LANCASHIRE WILL BE ABLE TO RUN KNIFE AMNESTIES, AND THIS WILL MAKE A HUGE DIFFERENCE TO THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN AND YOUNG ADULTS IN THOSE COMMUNITIES”. DANIELLA SUGGESTED THAT DUE TO THE CORONAVIRUS AND THE ECONOMIC IMPACT IT HAS HAD ON FAMILIES WITHIN THE AREA, SOME YOUTHS TAKE IT UPON THEMSELVES TO BE THE LEADER OF THE HOUSE. BUT PREVENT 2 PROTECT GIVE TROUBLED YOUTHS THE OPPORTUNITY TO REHABILITATE. THE CHARITY HAS BEEN SELECTED BY THE BUSINESS CO-OP TO RECEIVE A GRANT FOR THEIR PROJECT THROUGH THEIR LOCAL COMMUNITIES FUND. IT WAS REPORTED THAT AVERAGELY IN 2019, ACROSS GREATER MANCHESTER, THERE WAS NINE KNIFE CRIMES A DAY THAT WAS REPORTED TO THE POLICE, WHICH WAS NINE TOO MANY FOR SALFORD CITY COUNCILLOR, DAVID LANCASTER. IN RETURN TO THESE SHOCKING FIGURES, SALFORD CITY COUNCIL PLEDGED £300,000 TO TACKLE SALFORD KNIFE CRIME WITH SIX NEW

INITIATIVES IN OCTOBER 2019. COUNCILLOR LANCASTER ANNOUNCED IN OCTOBER LAST YEAR THAT: BEING DRAWN INTO CRIME JEOPARDISES THOSE CHANCES AND RISKS THEIR SAFETY BUT WITH THE RIGHT HELP AND SUPPORT, WE CAN HELP THEM TURN THINGS AROUND. CHANGES TO THE INITIAL GRANT PROPOSAL

WE WERE ASKED BY BRIGHTER FUTURES EDUCATION CENTRE IF WE COULD OFFER "LIFE SKILLS" CLASSES FOR THE BENEFICIARIES, SPECIFICALLY COOKING CLASSES. WE SAW THAT THERE WAS A NEED TO TEACH BENEFICIARIES HOW TO MAKE HEALTHY MEALS FROM SCRATCH ON A LOW BUDGET.

OUR TRUSTEES VOLUNTEERED THEIR OWN TIME TO PROVIDE THESE SESSIONS, AND ASDA IN SWINTON VERY KINDLY DONATED FOOD INGREDIENTS IN ORDER TO MAKE THESE SESSIONS POSSIBLE. WE ALSO VOLUNTEERED OUR TIME TO COOK THE BENEFICIARIES CHRISTMAS DINNER! BELOW, IS FEEDBACK RECEIVED AFTER THE COOKING CLASSES:

AT BRIGHTER FUTURES WE HAVE GROUPS OF STUDENTS FROM VARIOUS AUTHORITIES WHO ARE HERE TO BUILD ON SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND LIFE SKILLS, WE HAVE A RELAXED POLICY WHERE EVERY CHILD MATTERS AND WE LOOK AT INDIVIDUAL PLANS OF PROGRESSION AND SELF-AWARENESS. YOU CAME IN ON THURSDAY AND RAN SESSIONS WITH OUR LEARNERS COVERING COOKERY FROM SCRATCH AND SPORT, FITNESS AND WELL-BEING. ON POPULAR DEMAND YOU ALSO VISITED AGAIN! THIS WAS AGAIN COOKING AND FITNESS WITH A DIFFERENT GROUP OF LEARNERS. THE LEARNERS THOROUGHLY ENJOYED THE SESSIONS AND WE FELT IT WAS BENEFICIAL AND SUCCESSFUL, WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO FUTURE ENGAGEMENT AS THE STAFF ALSO BELIEVE THE ENTHUSIASM SHOWN BY YOURSELVES WAS A MASSIVE CONTRIBUTION TO THE LEARNERS PROGRESSION PLANS. THE STUDENTS WILL BE DOING AN EVALUATION SHEET AT SOME POINT OVER THE NEXT FEW WEEKS SO YOU WILL BE GIVEN ONE FOR EACH. WE WILL ADD THIS DOCUMENT INTO THE STUDENTS REVIEWS AND REPORTS. STUDENTS AND STAFF DISCUSSED THE SESSIONS AND AGREED THE SESSIONS WERE:

- WELL PRESENTED GREAT SESSIONS AND VARIED
- TUTORS RELATED WELL WITH LEARNERS
- APPROPRIATE LANGUAGE AT A LEVEL EASILY UNDERSTOOD
- EXERCISE WAS TARGETED AT LEARNERS' LEVELS AND ADAPTED ACCORDINGLY
